



## **Ride RMHC Weather Cancellation Policies**

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Northeast Indiana and the Ride RMHC committee value the safety of its participants and volunteers. If weather conditions (see list below) present a danger to Ride participants, RMHC NEIN maintains the right to cancel the ride. If possible, RMHC NEIN and the Ride RMHC committee will seek to alter the course or postpone the start of the ride to ensure participant safety. Inclement weather conditions are considered “Acts of God” and ride registrations will not be refunded.

### **Threatening Weather Conditions Include:**

Tornado Warning, Tornado Watch, Thunderstorm, “Heavy” Rain, Flooding, or other major weather conditions.

### **Postponement / Cancellation of Ride RMHC**

Ride RMHC may be delayed one hour from the posted start time if any of the above mentioned conditions exist. The event may then be canceled if any of the following weather conditions persist: Tornado Warning, Tornado Watch, Thunderstorm or Flooding.

If threatening weather conditions force cancellation of the event, no refunds can be provided, since funds were already spent in preparation for Ride RMHC.

In the event of cancellation, Ride RMHC participants will receive an email with information on how to pick up their event shirt.

### **Notice of Cancellation**

Registered participants will receive an email notifying them of cancellation. Additionally, a cancellation notice will be posted on our Facebook page (Ronald McDonald House Charities of Northeast Indiana at Parkview).

If weather conditions call for cancellation during the actual event, notifications will be made to participants and volunteers at Kreager Park and at SAG stops along the course.
