Who owns and operates the Ronald McDonald House?

The Ronald McDonald House is owned and operated by Ronald McDonald House Charities of Northeast Indiana. The Charity Chapter is governed by a Board of Trustees who is responsible for program development, standards and operations.

How is the Ronald McDonald House funded?

Generous supporters like you help fund the Ronald McDonald House. The majority of our programming funds come from individuals, organizations and businesses.

Doesn't McDonald's fund the Ronald McDonald House?

Local McDonald's restaurant owner/operators generously support our program and sponsor various events. However, the majority of the annual operating income comes from individual and other corporate donors.

How much does it cost to stay at the Ronald McDonald House?

The cost to operate a room is \$90 a night. Thanks to generous community support, families stay in the Ronald McDonald House at no cost.

Who is eligible to stay at the Ronald McDonald House?

Families of hospitalized children 21 and younger that is hospitalized due to illness, injury or in treatment, or patients up to 30 years old with chronic childhood disease.

How long do families usually stay at the Ronald McDonald House?

Stays can be as short as one night or as long as several months. Many families have multiple stays in the Ronald McDonald House.
