



Clays for Kids Weather Cancellation Policies

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Northeast Indiana and the Kids for Clays Foundation value the safety of its participants and volunteers. If weather conditions (see list below) present a danger to Clays for Kids participants, RMHC NEIN maintains the right to cancel the event. If possible, RMHC NEIN and the Kids for Clays Foundation will seek to alter the course or postpone the start of the ride to ensure participant safety. Inclement weather conditions are considered “Acts of God” and registrations will not be refunded.

Threatening Weather Conditions Include:

Tornado Warning, Tornado Watch, Thunderstorm, “Heavy” Rain, Flooding, or other major weather conditions.

Postponement / Cancellation of Clays for Kids

Clays for Kids may be delayed one hour from the posted start time if any of the above-mentioned conditions exist. The event may then be canceled if any of the following weather conditions persist: Tornado Warning, Tornado Watch, Thunderstorm or Flooding.

If threatening weather conditions force cancellation of the event, no refunds can be provided, since funds were already spent in preparation for Clays for Kids.

In the event of cancellation, participants will receive an email with information on how to pick up their shooter gift.

Notice of Cancellation
