

Programs

Ronald McDonald House

The Ronald McDonald House, located inside Parkview Regional Medical Center, gives families with a hospitalized child a home base. Ronald McDonald House volunteers and staff become the care team for a family during their stay, offering support services and encouragement throughout their journey. The Ronald McDonald House welcomes the families of pediatric patients 21 and younger either as overnight guests or day guests. We have 16 private guest rooms with semi-private bathrooms available to overnight guests 24 hours a day.



Ronald McDonald Family Lounge

For families with hospitalized babies, days can feel overwhelming. Thankfully, there's a place for them to recharge: the Ronald McDonald Family Lounge in the Parkview Women's and Children's Hospital Newborn Intensive Care Unit. Steps away from their child's bedside, the Family Lounge features a kitchenette stocked with grab-and-go snacks, a dining space, a comfortable lounge, and a children's play area.



Ronald McDonald Care Mobile

The Ronald McDonald Care Mobile team believes that a child's zip code shouldn't affect their ability to receive quality preventive care. The Care Mobile is a doctor's office on wheels, bringing wellness visits, vaccinations, and childhood health education into communities that need help accessing pediatric care. Now, children 0 – 18 years have more convenient access to health services, and at no charge to families without insurance.

Ronald McDonald House volunteers keep our program running smoothly 365 days a year. Volunteers keep the Ronald McDonald House tidy and welcoming; they assist guests at check-in and throughout their stay. They are often a listening ear and a shoulder to lean on.

Ronald McDonald House volunteer criteria:

- Must be 18 years or older.
- Volunteer opportunities range from 1 – 3 hour shifts, weekly. We ask that volunteers be prepared to stay with the organization for at least a year.
- Pass a background check.
